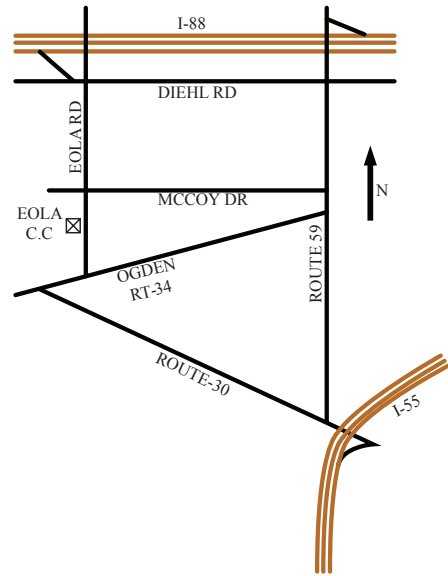

Directions:

From the East: Take I-88 west until Route 59 exit. At the light turn left. At the first light stop after crossing the bridge over I-88 ((Diehl Rd) turn west (right) and follow Diehl Rd for 2 miles until Eola Rd. Turn south (left) on Eola Rd. and follow it for 3.8 miles. The Eola Community Center will be the large brick building with green roof on your right.

From the West: Take I-88 East until Eola Rd. exit. After exit turn left onto Diehl Rd and continue until the first stop light – Eola Rd. Turn south (right) onto Eola Rd. and follow it for 3.8 miles. The Eola Community Center will be the large brick building with green roof on your right.

From the South: If travelling on I-55 north take the exit onto IL-Route 30 (Joliet Rd). Follow Joliet Rd for 2.2. miles and turn right on Division, then left onto Lockport St. Follow Lockport St. for 1 mile and turn right onto Wallin Dr. Follow it for 1 mile and it will turn into US. Route 30 W. Follow Route 30 for 7.5 miles until you reach Route 34 (Oswego Rd./Ogden Ave.) Turn right onto Route 34. and follow it for 2 miles until Eola Rd. Turn north (left) onto Eola and follow it for 0.5 miles until the light stop (Long Grove Dr). Turn left and the Eola Community Center & Aurora Library will be the large brick building with green roof on your right.



Free Clinic:

Sign up for a free clinic conducted by several local coaches between 8 – 9 am before the tournament. We will also demonstrate how to incorporate a table tennis robot into your training routine. Mark the 'Free clinic' box on the signup form if you are interested. Space is limited to 16 spots so register early.

Rules and Policies:

- Tournament management reserves the right to modify, combine, or cancel events, limit total participants or total entries by event. If event is cancelled the fees for this event will be refunded.
- All USATT regulations apply. Only USATT approved equipment will be used. 10 black Killerspin MyT10 Club Pro and 2 navy blue Stiga Prestige tables. 40 mm orange 3-star Nittaku balls.
- USATT Dress Code applies. The main body of the shirts, shorts and skirts must be significantly different than the color of the ball (orange). No orange or yellow shirts, shorts and skirts allowed.
- Do NOT enter two events with the same starting time. No player may enter more than 3 events.
- All matches are best 3 out of 5 games to 11 points.
- For Under 15 year old event the participant must be under 15 years old on the day of the tournament.
- For Over 50 year old event the participant must be 50 years old no later than Dec 31, 2012.
- For event eligibility the ratings as of May 25th, 2012 will be used. For seeding the events the ratings as of June 16th, 2012 will be used.
- No prizes will be awarded for splits, defaults and no-shows. Default time is event start time.
- Players must register at the desk no later than 30 minutes before the starting time of their earliest event.
- Gym will be open for practice from 8 – 9 am. Pre-match warm-up will be limited to 2 minutes.
- All events will be round robin in groups of 4. Group winners in the round robin phase advance to the single elimination phase.
- Unrated players may enter any event. However they will NOT advance from any rated round robin events. They can only advance from the 'Open' event.
- Withdrawals up through June 16th, 2012 will be eligible for full refunds. If registration was conducted online a \$2.00 processing fee will be subtracted.
- Any image, photographic or otherwise, taken of the tournament play or within the official venue is essentially the property of FVTTTC (Fox Valley Table Tennis Club). Entrants agree to allow their picture, voice and likeness to be reproduced in connection with FVTTTC by way of any medium.
