Rules and Policies

- Tournament management reserves the right to modify, combine, or cancel events, limit total participants or total entries by event. If event is cancelled the fees for this event will be refunded
- USATT Dress Code applies. The main body of the shirts, shorts and skirts must be significantly different than the color of the ball (white). No white shirts, shorts and skirts allowed.
- All USATT regulations apply. Only USATT approved equipment will be used: 12 blue Donic Waldner Classic 25 tables with blue Donic Stress nets and white 3-star Joola Prime 40+ plastic balls.
- All matches are best 3 out of 5 games to 11 points.
- The December 1, 2026, ratings will be used for event eligibility, and the December 15, 2026, ratings will be used for seeding.
- No prizes will be awarded for splits, defaults and no-shows. Default time is event start time.
- Players must register at the desk no later than 30 minutes before the starting time of their event.
- Gym will be open for practice from 8:30 am. Pre-match warm-up will be limited to 2 minutes.
- Unrated players will be given an estimated rating based on a recommendation from a coach who knows the player or through a direct visual evaluation, whenever possible. Unrated players may not advance from the round-robin stage of any event except the Open Singles and Open Doubles events.
- Withdrawals up through December 12, 2026 will be eligible for full refunds. After that date refunds will only be issued if there is someone on the waiting list who fills vacated spot.
- Any image, photographic or otherwise, taken of the tournament play or within the official venue is essentially the property of FVTTC (Fox Valley Table Tennis Club) and USATT.
- Entrants agree to allow their picture, voice and likeness to be reproduced in connection with FVTTC or USATT by way of any medium.

PERSONS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY MUST BE FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

Under USATT Safe Sport Policy, persons holding certain Positions of Authority must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for Safe Sport (once per year) and undergo a criminal background screen (every two years). The list of Positions of Authority requiring Full Safe Sport Compliance is set out in USATT's Safe Sport Policy and the Athlete Safety Section of the USATT Website: <https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tennis/athlete-safety/safe-sport>.

USATT COACHING POLICY

All persons who are engaged in coaching activities at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children, must be Fully Safe Sport Compliant, which requires completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

ADULT PARTICIPANTS REQUIRING SAFESPORT TRAINING

Pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, ALL Adult Participants (participants over the age of 18) who have regular contact with or authority over minor aged athletes must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year ("SafeSport Trained").

CONTACT USATT TO BECOME SAFESPORT TRAINED AND/OR FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

USATT is pleased to assist USATT Members in the process of becoming SafeSport Trained and/or Fully Safe Sport Compliant. Please contact USATT at Admin@usatt.org for more information and guidance in this process.

MANDATORY REPORTING

There are certain circumstances where reporting a potential Safe Sport violation is mandatory. These circumstances include: (i) child abuse; (ii) sexual misconduct; (iii) emotional and physical misconduct; (iv) criminal charges and/or dispositions involving sexual misconduct or misconduct involving minors; (v) any abuse of the Safe Sport process. Child abuse must be immediately reported to local law enforcement.
